

1.0 About us

CAN Tanzania is a Non-Governmental and not for profit organization with its headquarters in Dar es Salaam. Its establishment has been a critical step towards empowering Tanzanians to be more aware of climate change and related issues. Importantly, it was hinged on as a vision in developing a networking structure that would be able to reach a wider community in the country.

Our work targets the adoption of Low Carbon Growth, poverty reduction through enhanced community livelihood activities and hence a climate resilient-economy among citizens. We also strive to localize the international climate agenda and agreements into our local context. 2.0 Categories of Membership

CAN Tanzania alienated its membership into four (4) categories.

2.1 Silver (voting) Membership:

This category is open to national and regional non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations and Faith-based organizations that work, support and/or engage on environment and natural resources management and conservation, climate change adaptation and mitigation, renewable energies, green growth, community development and sustainable development in Tanzania.

2.2 Platinum (non-voting) Membership:

The category is open to international non-governmental organizations, networks, think tank, research institutions, academia, agencies and authorities, cooperates and companies that operate, work, support and/or engage on environment and natural resources management and conservation, climate change adaptation and mitigation, renewable energies, green growth, community development and sustainable development within and beyond Tanzania.

2.3 Gold (non-voting) Membership:

This category opens to all individuals (such as consultants, professionals, lecturers, researchers etc) that have a significant contribution to the society and would like to join CAN Tanzania to do more to the network and society as well and moreover has done work, support and/or engage on environment and natural resources management and conservation, climate change adaptation and mitigation, renewable energies, green growth, community development and sustainable development within and beyond Tanzania (*If one interested in this category, please contact CAN Tanzania team for guidance*)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

2.4 Diamond (non-voting) Membership:

The category opens to any organization/person that operates within and beyond Tanzania and has ambition to support and/or sponsor the works done by CAN Tanzania in its efforts to fight against climate change, building climate resilience society while promoting sustainable development.

3.0 Membership Fee

All members are obliged/required to pay a nonrefundable entry fee which is paid once and annual membership fee, all these are determined and approved by the Annual General Meeting and will be reviewed from time to time as of the raised necessities. All annual membership fee shall be payable to CAN Tanzania Country Secretariat in advance or in the first quarter of each calendar year while entry fees payable once during the registration. CAN Tanzania team may decide to grant partial or full membership fees waivers to specific members, membership waivers are granted upon application to CAN Tanzania. 4.0 Benefits of Membership to CAN Tanzania

- 4.1 Members are eligible to take part into lawfully CAN Tanzania organized events including: trainings, workshops, visits, meetings and other activities at national, regional and international levels accordingly.

- 4.3 Networking with other likeminded NGOs and initiatives at national and international levels.
- 4.4 Receive climate change related technical supports from the secretariat and member organizations.
- 4.5 Learning and sharing best practices and case studies within CAN network.

5.0 Members' Compulsions to CAN Tanzania

- 5.1 Adhere to CAN Tanzania Constitution and policies.
- 5.2 Pay annual membership fees.
- 5.3 Take part in the implementation of CAN Tanzania activities approved by the AGM where necessary and needed.
- 5.4 Promoting CAN Tanzania and its obligations.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

6.0 Termination of Membership

Membership to CAN Tanzania shall cease upon evidently occurrence of any of the following events:

- 6.1 If a Member voluntarily resigns by a written notice duly served to the CAN Tanzania secretariat.
- 6.2 If a Member is summarily terminated from CAN Tanzania membership by the Annual General Meeting for ceasing to share the spirit and compliance of CAN Tanzania constitution.
- 6.3 Upon legally deregistration from and/or by relevant registrar, a member shall lose its membership as Full Member.
- 6.4 If a member fails to pay annual membership fee for three years consecutively with or without notes.
- 6.5 Resigned and /or terminated member can apply to revive their registration at any time, the decision to revive a registration is taken by the CAN Tanzania secretariat through Board of Directors.

7.0 Qualifications for CAN Tanzania Membership

- 7.1 Be a legally registered organization with at least two years of operation.
- 7.2 Support, operate and engage in environment and natural resources management and conservation, climate change adaptation and mitigation, renewable energies, green growth, community development and sustainable development within and beyond Tanzania.
- 7.3 Individuals/Institutions/ organisations implementing relevant projects or programs
- 7.4 Actively promote indigenous knowledge and skills in sustainable development and natural resources management.
- 7.5 Be devoted and enthusiastic to share knowledge and skills through networking with other CAN Tanzania members.
